Mount Auburn Cemetery, an active burial place and vibrant cultural institution, seeks a new president. Founded in 1831, Mount Auburn was the first large-scale designed landscape open to the public in North America, and it helped inspire the creation of America's public parks. A National Historic Landmark, Mount Auburn's beauty, historical associations, architecture, monuments, landscapes, and horticultural collections are internationally renowned.

The president is the chief executive officer of Mount Auburn Cemetery, serves as its principal public spokesperson, and provides vision and leadership for its multi-faceted services and programs. Reporting to a 14-member Board of Trustees and serving as a member of that board, the president leads a full-time staff of 64, along with an additional 46 seasonal and part-time workers and a cadre of volunteers. Mount Auburn's \$10 million annual budget is supported by an endowment of approximately \$150 million and by earned revenues from cemetery services and funds raised through Mount Auburn's charitable arm, the Friends of Mount Auburn Cemetery.

Building on the framework of Mount Auburn's award-winning master plan and its recent strategic planning work, the new president is expected to ensure that the cemetery, its services, and its programs continue to meet the highest standards of excellence and innovation. The position calls for a creative leader with highly developed business skills and financial savvy as well as deep commitment to the unique mission of Mount Auburn Cemetery. Outstanding communication and interpersonal abilities are also essential and successful experience in fund raising is highly desirable.
