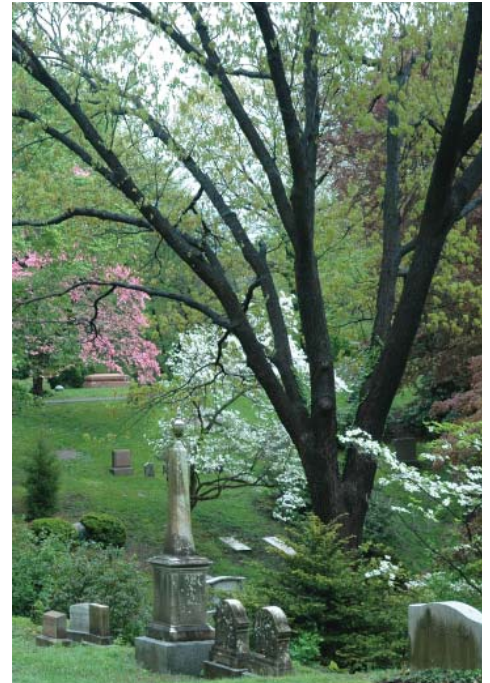
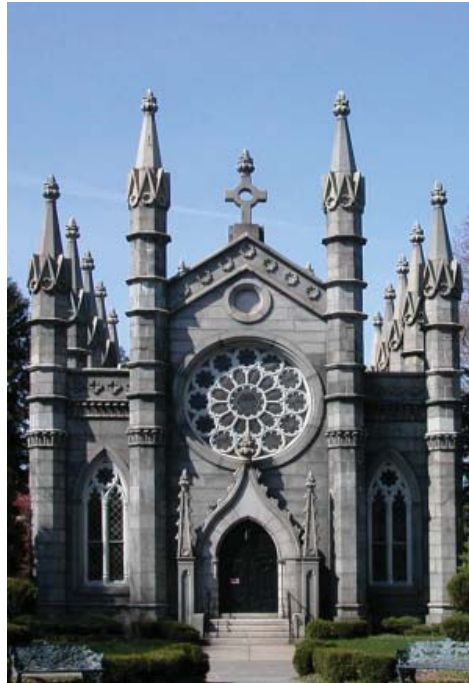

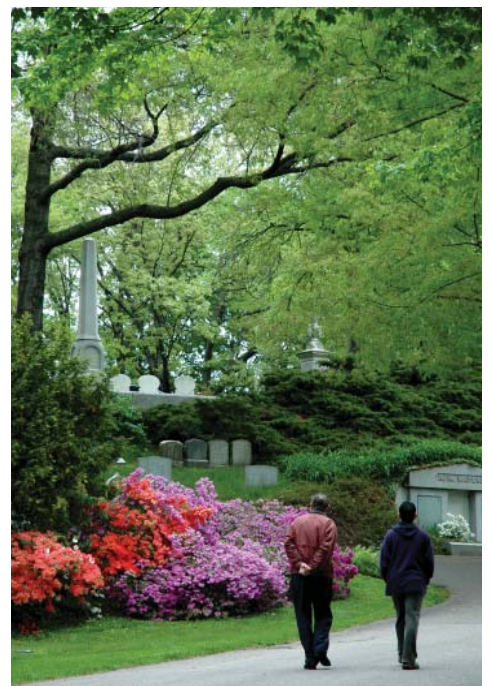
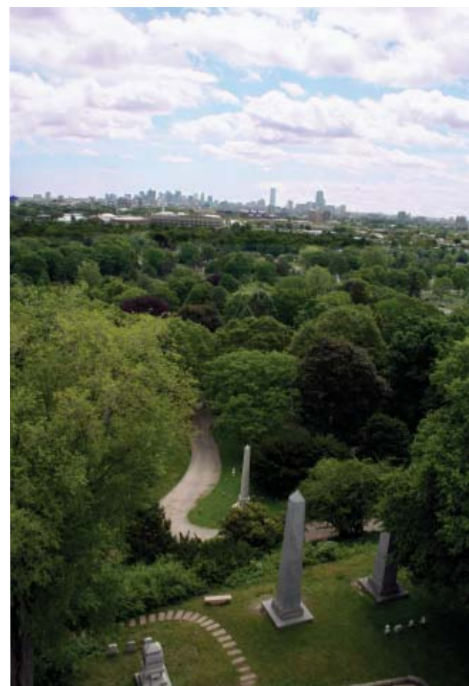
*left:* Bigelow Chapel, Mount Auburn's
